Dear Scholarship Applicant:

The objective of the KCFB Foundation's scholarship program is to assist students pursuing higher education and agriculture-related jobs and careers. Scholarships are available for both high school seniors and college students. Additional prerequisites are listed below:

[Kane County Farm Bureau Foundation Agricultural Scholarship](#): (\$1,000 minimum) For students pursuing degrees in agriculture related career fields whose parents are, & have been for the past two years, members of the Kane County Farm Bureau. Members must be in good standing, with dues paid in full, when applying.

[President's Scholarship](#) (\$1,500 minimum) For the most outstanding application for a KCFB Foundation Agricultural Scholarship from a **high school senior**.

[Kane County Farm Bureau Foundation General Scholarship](#): (\$1,000 minimum) For **high school seniors only** whose parents are, & have been for the past two years, members of the Kane County Farm Bureau. Members must be in good standing, with dues paid in full, when applying.

[Mary L. Heckel-Blickle Memorial Scholarship](#): (\$1,000 minimum) One award for a student residing in Kane or Macon County, Ill. pursuing a degree in an agriculture related career field.

[John Buck Memorial Scholarship](#): (\$1,000) One award for a student from Kane, DeKalb, McHenry, Boone, DuPage, Lake or Will County pursuing a degree in an agriculture field with preference given to students with agricultural mechanics and turf management career ambitions.

[Chuck Swanson Memorial Scholarships](#): (\$1,000 minimum) Up to three awards for students residing in Kane County pursuing a degree in an agriculture related career field.

[AGCO Parts - AGCO Global Women's Network Scholarship](#): (\$1000 minimum) One award for a **female student** in Illinois pursuing a degree in agricultural related career field of study

[AGCO Parts Division Scholarship](#): (\$1000 minimum) One award for a student from Illinois pursuing a degree in an agriculture related career field of study

Applications will be judged by the KCFB Foundation Board of Directors. Students who meet eligibility requirements may apply for any or all scholarships on the same application.

Applications are available at www.kanecfb.com & must be submitted by Feb. 15, 2017. If mailed, must be postmarked by Feb. 15, 2017. If e-mailed, must be received by Feb. 15, 2017. (Call 630-584-8660 to verify receipt if submitting by e-mail). Scholarship recipients announced by April 1.
