**Agricultural Scholarships:**(\$1,000 minimum)

For students pursuing degrees in agriculture related career fields whose parents are, and have been for the past two years, members of the Kane County Farm Bureau.

**General Scholarship** (\$1,000 minimum)

For high school seniors only whose parents are, & have been for the past two years, members of the Kane County Farm Bureau.

**President's Scholarship** (\$1,500 minimum)

The most outstanding application for a KCFB Foundation Scholarship from a high school senior will receive the award.

**John Buck Memorial Scholarship** (\$1,000)

for college education are available to students from Kane, DeKalb, McHenry, Boone, DuPage, Lake, or Will counties pursuing higher education in agriculture related fields.

**Chuck Swanson Memorial Scholarship**

(\$1,000 minimum) was established by the family and friends of the former Farm Bureau Director and long-time volunteer to provide awards for students residing in Kane County pursuing a degree in an agriculture related career field.

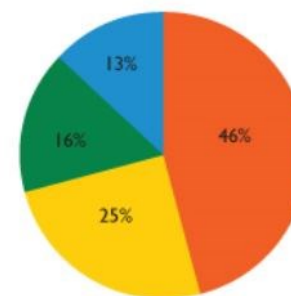
